# Photographs

Photographs will be taken on Monday, September 30 during rehearsal.

Please follow the following guidelines for what to wear to look your best:

- ★ no words, large logos, or pictures on the front of your clothes
- ★ avoid distracting patterns like stripes and polka dots
- ★ make sure it fits and that you feel comfortable and confident

Candid photographs will be taken at some rehearsals and a large group photo of the entire cast, crew and orchestra will be taken during show week. For the large group photo, the cast will be dressed in costume, the orchestra will dress in performance black and crew members will dress in all black

# **Ticket Ordering**

You may order your tickets at any time online, beginning **Monday**, **September 30**. This is the date that the online system will be open to the public.

Prior to that, beginning **Saturday**, **September 21 at 9:00AM** you will be given the opportunity to order through a Pre-Sale. Musical participants will be given a presale code to allow early access to the ticket system. The website link and pre-sale code will be mailed to each musical participant a few days prior ro pre-sale.

Please be aware that all seating is reserved. You will be able to select your seats during the online ordering process. Therefore, if you wish to reserve seats together, be sure to know how many you need before you go online. We will have no ability to get nearby seats for you at a later date.

## Costume Information

All students will be provided costumes to wear during the show.

There are several things you'll be expected to provide for dress rehearsals and performances:

#### Footwear

- Show footwear to be confirmed.
- For rehearsal, please wear jazz shoes or sneakers.

#### Hygiene

- Neutral-colored camisole, undershirt, leotard, shorts, and/or tights everyone is **REQUIRED** to wear something under their costume. Students will get ready in shared backstage dressing rooms, and undergarments make costume changes a breeze!
- Deodorant! Please.

#### Hair

- A fine-toothed comb or a brush
- Extra-hold hairspray
- Bobby pins and elastics (for long hair) that match their hair. If students have long hair or bangs, they should choose a hairstyle that keeps hair out of their faces for the entirety of the show (braids, ponytails, buns, etc). We may ask for a particular hairstyle for certain characters as we get closer to the show.

### **Makeup** (for everyone of all genders):

- Eyeliner and mascara in dark brown or black. Stage lights have a tendency to wash out the skin and make eyes disappear onstage.
- Pink or red lipstick
- Setting powder or pressed powder, to keep faces looking shine-free under the lights.
- Optional: foundation or concealer that matches skin tone
- Makeup remover and cotton balls/cotton rounds; makeup remover wipes; or baby wipes, for removing makeup or fixing makeup mistakes.
- Additional makeup may be recommended depending on character
